**About the Pragmatic Arts Program**  
 This class is designed for students who struggle with peer relationships and social skills. The program is for elementary age students who present with profiles such as autism spectrum disorders or other social cognition challenges. Conducted by an Artist Facilitator skilled at working with children of all kinds, this series of carefully structured and professionally taught classes uses visual, dramatic, and movement arts to help convey social expectations while guiding social responses and self-expression. Research has suggested that—beyond addressing social skills challenges—art projects may promote the development of abstract thinking skills, better hand-eye coordination and spatial recognition, and more patience and flexibility for conquering tasks.

**Policy for Children:**  
 For the safety of children, we ask that they be dropped off directly to their teacher in the classroom and remain with the teacher until picked up by a parent or authorized adult. If a child is allowed to leave after class on their own, a note from the parent or guardian stating so is required before the first class.

**Cancellation & Withdrawal:**  
 Courses cancelled due to insufficient enrollment will be 100% refunded. Refunds for withdrawals within two weeks prior to the first class are subject to a \$25 processing fee. For withdrawals less than one week before the start of class we offer a 50% refund. To withdraw from a vacation program, written notice must be received two weeks before the program begins. A \$50 registration fee and extended day tuition are non-refundable for vacation programs.

**Parking & Drop-Off:**  
 NEVER stop your car in our driveway and drop off your children... PLEASE pull into the lot and park or drop your children off on OUR side of Mass. Ave in front of Munroe. Please DO NOT PARK ALONG THE FENCE in the lot at the side of the building. It is too difficult to see children exiting from cars to cross our very busy lot. **Building Restoration Fee:**  
 Munroe Center for the Arts has instituted a modest Building Restoration Fee required for all students taking classes at any school at Munroe to address the less capital-intensive parts of building restoration. This \$25 fee for each student--with a \$60 maximum per family--will be assessed each academic year, beginning with fall registrations. Please remember that this fee is due only **once** a year. This fee demonstrates our collective dedication to revitalizing this much-beloved home for the arts in Lexington. If you have already paid your Restoration Fee with another registration for one of the other Munroe Schools (i.e. Lexington School of Ballet or The Dance Inn), you do not need to pay an additional fee for ArtSpan registrations.
