



COVID-19 POLICY

November 29, 2021

We value the health and safety of all our artists, staff, teachers, students, and visitors. We thank you for being here, and ask for your help in staying vigilant and helping one another through this pandemic.

As of January 10, 2022, **students** the Munroe Center for the Arts building who are eligible must show proof of at least the first vaccination shot, or provide an exemption letter. As of January 31, 2022, full vaccination is required (i.e., two weeks after the second dose in a two-dose series or two weeks after a single-dose vaccine). This extends to any **caregiver** who may be spending longer than 15 minutes in the building at a given time.

All **staff, teachers, and volunteers** at the Munroe Center for the Arts are fully vaccinated, and any new staff, teachers and volunteers who will be in the building will be required to show proof of full vaccination, or provide an exemption letter.

VACCINATION EXEMPTIONS:

- For **religious exemptions**, individuals must produce a letter stating how the COVID-19 vaccination conflicts with or violates their sincere religious beliefs.
- For a **medical exemption**, individuals must produce a letter by a licensed health care provider that specifically addresses that the COVID-19 vaccination cannot be received and certifies that the licensed health care provider has personally examined the individual and is of the opinion that the patient's health would be endangered by the immunization.

Regardless of vaccination status, everyone entering the building must **wear a mask** in all public spaces and studios. Each school, as well as the main office maintains a supply of sanitizer and disposable masks for anyone in need.

Anyone **feeling unwell** with cold, flu, or COVID-19 symptoms, however minor, needs to **stay out of the building**.

Regular **cleaning** and disinfecting of touchpoints happens on a daily basis, and classrooms are ventilated with HEPA filtration units, or air purifiers that produce 4 air exchanges/hour.

If a student tests positive at any point, they need to let their teacher at the Munroe Center for the Arts know so that administrative staff here can ascertain if they were infectious when they were in the building.
